

SO YOU THINK YOU HAVE A GOOD HORSE
THEN BET ON HIM!

At Cave Creek Cutting Horse Association (CCCHA) we are committed to the beginning cutter who wants to learn the sport of cutting and someday be a very competitive cutter. We also recognize that some of our members and their trainers would like to see bigger payouts when their horses do well to help compensate for the time and expense of coming to a show. The only way we can payout more is to charge more in entry fees which defeats our primary mission of providing the beginning cutter a reasonably economical way to participate in and learn the sport of cutting.

For those that would like to compete on a higher financial level with higher financial rewards (and risks) we are offering the following for our 2010 year. We are calling it the "Money Class" and the way it works is this. There will be a class within a class on selected CCCHA classes. The "Money Class" entrants will pay an additional entry fee and will compete for the money only against those who have entered the "Money Class within a class". The additional entry fee money will be a 100% payout according to NCHA payout guidelines plus the jackpotted entry fee for the class. Regular yearend awards will be determined by the normal point system used by CCCHA.

For our initial year of the "Money Class Within a Class" the additional entry fee is as follows for those wanting to participate in the "Money Class":

Open "Money Class" = \$100 additional entry fee

Non Pro "Money Class" = \$100 additional entry fee

\$10000 Novice Horse "Money Class" = \$100 additional entry fee

\$2000 Rider "Money Class" = \$50 additional entry fee

\$15000 Amateur "Money Class" = \$50 additional entry fee

\$3000 Novice Horse "Money Class" = \$50 additional entry fee

For now there will be no "Money Classes" for the Youth, \$500 Rider, \$1000 Rider and Practice Work.
